**Your Kitten's Vaccine Schedule:**

8 weeks	Upper Respiratory Vaccine (FVRCP)
12 weeks	Upper Respiratory Vaccine and Leukemia Vaccine (FVRCP + Leukemia)
16 weeks	Upper Respiratory Vaccine, Leukemia Vaccine and Rabies (FVRCP + Leukemia + Rabies)
Annual vaccines for Cats are done 1 year after their 16 week vaccines.  An annual vaccine includes:  <b>Upper Respiratory +/- Leukemia Rabies</b>	

**Spay/Neuter:** We recommend that every animal be spayed or neutered. Talk to your Veterinarian about what age would be the best to be altered.



**Pet Wellness Exam (PWE)** – This is a complementary exam that is included with your cat's annual exam/vaccines each year. This PWE is provided 6 months after your pet's annual. You will be notified that your cat can come back for this complementary wellness exam (PWE) anytime within that month. We include the PWE because pets age much quicker than we do! Your pet seeing us every year is the equivalent to you going to your doctor only every 7 years. This is why we feel it is necessary to see your pet at least twice a year.

**Cobequid Care Package (CCP)** – Preventative health care is the most efficient approach to detect disease prior to symptoms appearing, and before treatment options become costly, challenging and/or limited. This package includes the physical exam, annual vaccines, bloodwork, urinalysis, fecal, & nail trim. A Cobequid Care Package, as it includes a physical exam and vaccines, is suggested to be done at the time of your pet's annual visit. You will still receive your PWE, 6 months later.

**Dental Cleaning:** Oral health is good for the overall health of your new pet. If plaque is not removed on a regular basis, hard tartar may begin to form. Buildup of both causes gingivitis, that results in painful inflammation and can lead to infection. Bacteria from the mouth can also travel through the body causing further preventable complications. At home dental care (brushing teeth, chews or a dental diet) can be a huge help to keep the teeth clean. A dental cleaning is also an effective way to remove harmful plaque and tartar.

**Pet Insurance** – We recommend that all animals have Pet Insurance. We can set you up with a FREE trial of Pet Insurance (Pets Plus Us or Trupanion) at your first appointment. Having pet insurance coverage will give you peace of mind that you will always be financially prepared to give your pet the best care. Accidents & Illnesses can happen any point in your pet's life.
